



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT BUSINESS RECYCLING

Types of material to recycle:

- ✓ Clean, dry paper
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Plastic and glass bottles
- ✓ Metal and aluminum cans
- ✓ Metal containers
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Plastic bags

Do not put in Dumpster:

- Broken glass
- Wet paint
- Rubber tires
- Hazardous Waste- paint, batteries, pesticides, clean products, appliances, motor fluids, cell phones, TVs, computer monitors

Why Recycle?

State law now requires all businesses that generates 4 or more cubic yards of waste weekly to recycle.

Recycling may provide opportunities for your business to save money.

Recycling conserves resources and creates a healthy environment for our community.

How Does it Works?

The City of Stanton uses a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) to process waste and recyclables . Here is how it works:

Step 1: Place waste in the dumpster. **To increase recycling and diversion, bag wet waste separately and place in the bin.**

Step 2: Waste is taken to the MRF where recyclables are separated by a combination of manual and mechanical sorting. Recyclables are separated and shipped to recycling markets and residue waste is sent to a disposal facility

Note: CR&R has a cardboard recycling program available to all commercial account at no charge. Contact CR&R for more information.

- Any business may donate, sell, and/or otherwise arrange for the recycling of materials.
