

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

Sealed proposals for the work shown on the plans entitled:

**Kermore Lane Reconstruction Project (from Knott Avenue to Lowden Street)**

in the City of Stanton will be received at the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Stanton, 7800 Katella Avenue, Stanton, CA 90680-3162 until **10:00AM on Monday, May 23, 2016** at which time they will be publicly opened and read. A **mandatory pre-bid site inspection will be held on Wednesday, May 11, 2016 at 1:30 P.M.** Lack of attendance will result in disqualification of bid proposals.

All bid proposals shall be made on the proposal forms furnished by the City and placed, together with the accompanying documents and security, in a sealed package marked outside with the title of the project and "SEALED BID FOR THE CITY OF STANTON" - DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL" and addressed to the City Clerk at the above address in a sealed envelope.

All bid proposals must comply with the requirements contained in this Notice and in the specifications and other contract documents. All bids in apparent compliance with such requirements shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time at the place of bid receipt identified above.

The Contractor shall furnish all necessary materials, labor, equipment and other incidental and appurtenant work necessary for the proper construction of this project, including but not limited to the cold milling and disposal of existing AC pavement and concrete pavement surfaces, construction of AC pavement, traffic striping, pavement markings, manhole adjustments, and other items of work required to complete the scope of work detailed in the plans and specifications complete and in place.

**OBTAINING CONTRACT**

**DOCUMENTS:** Contract documents for the above-referenced project may be obtained at the City of Stanton - Public

Works Department, 7800 Katella Avenue, Stanton CA, for a non-refundable fee of \$30 if picked up or \$40 if mailed or free electronic set of bid documents can be requested by email at [acruz@ci.stanton.ca.us](mailto:acruz@ci.stanton.ca.us). No bid proposal will be received unless it is made on the official proposal forms furnished by the City, is accompanied by an executed Non-Collusion Affidavit and is accompanied by cash, a certified or cashier's check payable to the City or a satisfactory bidder's bond in favor of the City executed by the bidder as principal and a satisfactory surety company as surety, in an amount not less than 10% of the bid amount, as provided in Public Contract Code section § 20170 et. seq. Should the bidder to whom the contract is awarded fail to enter into the subject contract, such bid security shall be forfeited pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20172, except as otherwise provided in Public Contract Code section § 20174.

All work shall be completed within **40 working days** following the date specified in the written notice to proceed from the City.

Contractor shall comply with the requirements of SB 854. SB 854 requires all contractors and subcontractors bidding on public works projects to register with the Department of Industrial Relations and to pay an annual fee. The registration requires contractors to provide the State with evidence of the contractors' compliance with a number of statutory requirements.

At the time of the award of the contract, the successful bidder shall possess a valid contractor's license, and shall comply with any applicable City requirements concerning contractor qualifications. Submission of a bid by a bidder without a license subjects the bidder to civil penalties pursuant to Business & Professions Code section § 7028.15. The bidder must possess a Class-A Contractor License in the State of California. No contract will be awarded to any bidder who is not a properly licensed California contractor as required by the California Business and Professions Code.

As provided for in section 22300 of the Public Contracts Code, the Contractor

may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the City to ensure performance under the Contract.

The Contractor shall not begin work under the Agreement until it has given the City evidence of comprehensive public liability insurance and Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage together with additional Insured Endorsements. The successful Contractor shall also furnish 2 bonds required by the State Contract Act. Each of the said bonds shall be executed in a sum equal to the contract price. One of the said bonds shall guarantee the faithful performance of the said contract by the Contractor, and the other said bond shall secure the payment of claims for labor and material. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any parts thereof, and to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding, and to make awards in all or part in the best interests of the City.

**PREVAILING WAGE**


**REQUIREMENTS:** In accordance with the provisions of Section 1770, et seq., of the Labor Code, the Director of the Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the general prevailing rate of wages applicable to the work to be done. The Contractor and subcontractor will be required to pay to all persons employed on the project by the Contractor sums not less than the sums set forth in the documents entitled "General Prevailing Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations pursuant to California Labor Code, Part 7, Chapter 1, Article 2, Sections 1770, 1773, 1773.1."

**TRADES/SUPPLIER DIVISIONS NEEDED BUT NOT LIMITED TO:**

Concrete, Asphalt, and Construction Clean-up.

**WITHDRAWAL OF BID:** No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the date set for the opening of bids.
