Dear Neighbor:

On June 23rd the Stanton City Council adopted the City's new two-year budget. I am writing to provide a budget update and thank the community for participating in the election for Measure GG – the Stanton 9-1-1 Public Safety and Essential City Services Protection Measure – that has allowed the City to maintain and enhance essential city services.

Thanks to the community's support of Measure GG this past November, the City adopted its first balanced budget in seven years and avoided millions of dollars in service cuts. This year's budget maintains and improves essential local services, including:

- Fire protection services
- Additional sheriff's deputies and neighborhood police patrols
- Rapid 9-1-1 response times
- Anti-gang and youth violence prevention programs
- Economic development programs to help create jobs and fix blight
- Senior programs

However, the City also recognizes that funding for these public safety programs and other critical services may be over-turned. It has recently come to the City's attention that petitions are circulating that may result in Measure GG local funding ending.

To be fiscally responsible, the City Council has adopted an alternate budget that considers the potential loss of this local funding source. It includes significant cuts to critical public safety services including, gang and drug prevention, police officer staffing at local schools, neighborhood police patrols, and graffiti removal, as well as considering reducing firefighter staffing levels. Maintaining this voter-approved local funding source is essential to keeping our community safe.

Thanks to the community's participation in the election for Measure GG, voter-enacted local funding has helped restore and improve critical city services for the community. This local funding has allowed Stanton to maintain public safety and economic development programs including:

- Current levels of fire protection services and firefighters
- Neighborhood police patrols
- 9-1-1 emergency response times
- Gang and youth violence prevention programs
- Programs attracting businesses to Stanton and creating jobs

DID YOU KNOW:

- Voter-approved, local funding has allowed Stanton to add a **Community Enhancement Deputy** to improve community policing, address gang/youth violence, homelessness and fight prostitution and illegal massage parlors. A new **Motor Deputy** was also added to enforce traffic laws on our major roadways, residential streets and in school zones to improve traffic safety for all.

- Stanton can now add a **Code Enforcement Officer** to help cleanup gang tagging and graffiti; address transient issues; and respond to quality-of-life complaints, thanks to voter-approved, local funding. This will give deputies more time to focus on **neighborhood patrols** and respond to emergencies.

- Voter-approved, local funding has allowed Stanton to enhance its economic development programs to **attract new businesses, create local jobs, help fix blighted areas** and improve our local economy.
