Because of the passage of Measure GG in 2014, funding for additional law enforcement personnel has been available to work with our families and students in crisis as well as to assist District staff with a myriad of essential services. These crucial resources have included conducting home visits, substantiating custody issues, providing address verifications, and ensuring motorists obey traffic laws when our school buses are loading and unloading students, to name just a few. In addition, the passage of Measure GG has ensured crossing guards are available at the busiest intersections, allowing children and parents to walk to and from school safely. Indeed, the additional law enforcement personnel and provision of school crossing guards are an essential aspect of public safety for our children, parents, and community.

It is our sincere hope that the repeal of the one cent sales tax, Measure QQ, will be defeated so that our children, families, and community will continue to have essential services through the funding of increased law enforcement personnel and crossing guards that are so very much needed in our community.
