city manager's message



As 2022 comes to a close, we have an opportunity to reflect on our accomplishments and progress as a community while preparing and planning for 2023.

Development projects continue to make great progress in the

City and Beach Boulevard continues to evolve with new housing opportunities. Among them include the Cloudhouse Apartment Community, Bigsby Condo Community, and the Katella Assemblage & Lighthouse Condo Communities.

Project Homekey is making great strides to convert Stanton Inn & Suites, Tahiti Motel and Riviera Motel into 132 permanent supportive housing units. These developments are under construction or will soon break ground and we're excited for the City's continued growth.

The City will also soon welcome new residents at the VRV Apartments, located on Beach Boulevard across the street from Rodeo 39. The project will be opening in phases, with the first phase to occur early 2023.

The Stanton business community continues to thrive. Super King recently had its grand re-opening in its new building in Magnolia Plaza. Its former location is undergoing façade and site improvements to bring a contemporary and updated look to the shopping center.

In an effort to reduce waste in California, the State passed SB1383, which requires businesses and residents to participate in organic recycling. To meet the demands set forward by the state, the City of Stanton is establishing a new three bin waste system with the help of CR&R to ensure that all organic and recyclable waste is being properly diverted from the waste stream.

The City will be working with CR&R and MSW Consultants to ensure that all businesses are receiving the proper bins and services levels to meet state requirements.

The Community Services Department, in partnership with RJM Design Group, has completed the public input phase of our upcoming Parks Master Plan, which will identify community needs and create a roadmap for Stanton parks for the next fifteen years.

Thank you to everyone who participated in our public workshops and online surveys this fall, your input is vital to creating our plan. The Parks Master Plan is anticipated to be complete by May 2023. To follow along with our progress, please visit www.StantonParksMasterPlan.com.
