city manager's message



Hello Stanton residents! I hope you are enjoying this amazing spring weather and looking forward to the transition to summer as much as I am.

In July, we'll celebrate Parks Make Life Better month and take advantage of the summer sun with a calendar full

of events and activities for the whole family. Be sure to join in on the festivities with our refrigerator calendar on the last page of this brochure and participate in our annual photo and drawing contests.

With the Fourth of July coming up, I'd also like to remind everyone to be safe and careful while celebrating the holiday, and please only light safe and sane fireworks. Possession of illegal fireworks is a crime and is punishable by law with fines ranging from \$1,000-\$80,000 per violation. You can report inprogress illegal firework discharge to OCSD by calling (714) 647-7000.

If you haven't had a chance already, I encourage you to check out our engagement platform, LetsTalkStanton.com, for updates in the world of Community and Economic Development. Our latest feature, "Make Your Mark," is an interactive, crowdsourced map and an all-in-one resource to help you Shop Stanton! Community members and Stanton business owners are encouraged to add their favorite Stanton businesses to the map. Whether you're looking for a new place to get your oil changed or a new coffee shop, our Stanton Business Map will guide you to the right place.

Our Public Works Department is busy making improvements to a variety of public spaces and places this summer. We are currently in the design phase for the following projects, and will have design samples ready for public viewing in the upcoming months: interior and exterior renovations at the Family Resource Center, design for the new Orangewood Parkette which includes three (3) playground sites, rubber play surface and shade structures, and a new dog park located at the vacant underutilized lot that runs diagonally east-southeast from Western Avenue

to Cerritos Avenue which includes a bike trail, drought tolerant landscaping, and dog agility equipment.

This winter, City staff soft launched our Public Service Request App at StantonCA.gov/PSR, connecting residents directly to City staff. This application can be used to report Public Works, Code Enforcement and Encampment issues in your neighborhoods seven days a week. As a reminder, we ask that users please create an account prior to submitting a request so that we can reach out to you with any questions or follow-up conversations. So far, we are happy with the response we've received and are proud to continue to expand our communication efforts and connection with our community.

I invite you to read through the rest of the Stanton Express to learn more about the activities our Community Services Department has in store for you this summer! I am especially excited about the launch of the "Everyone Plays" scholarship program that creates opportunities for all Stanton residents to enjoy our fee-based enrichment classes, while giving local businesses a way to give back to their community through their generous support of the scholarship program.



APPROVED UPDATED DISTRICT ELECTION MAP





CITY COUNCIL APPROVES UPDATED DISTRICT MAP

Thanks to your involvement with the redistricting process and assisting the City in redrawing district lines, the Stanton City Council has selected and adopted Public Map Cv2, implementing new electoral district boundaries. The new districts will be used for City Council elections starting with the November 2022 election.

- Two Council Member seats will be up for election and shall be elected "by-district" (District 1 and District 3) along with the at-large Mayor.
- · Only residents that live in those respective districts up for election can cast ballots for their candidate of choice.
- The election of the Mayor will remain "at-large" meaning elected by all voters of the city, no matter where in the city you live.
- The Orange County Registrar of Voters has obtained data from the City of Stanton to integrate into its precinct system to determine which voters are in which districts (based on the City Council approved map) and who will need a ballot.

The City wants all registered voters in District 1 and District 3 to be aware and prepared for the November 2022 General Municipal Election in our City. For more information and to determine what district you live in, please visit the City's website at www.StantonCA.gov/DistrictElections. Here you will find an interactive web map where residents can enter an address to determine which district they are in or view a copy of the approved boundary map and demographic data for each district.
